Dive Into Pool Season Prep with a Splash of Conservation

As the weather warms and days get longer, make sure your pool is in top shape and ready for the summer fun ahead. Even with proper and regular pool maintenance, many Las Vegas pool professionals recommend draining your swimming pool—either completely or partially—every three to five years.

While draining your pool into the street is tempting and may seem convenient, local waterwaste ordinances prohibit discharging pool water to the street or storm drains; all water must be drained directly to the sanitary sewer system. This allows the water to be treated and returned to Lake Mead for reuse, which decreases the strain on our community's resources and helps with our conservation efforts.

You do not need to notify the Southern Nevada Water Authority (SNWA) or your local water provider when you drain your pool. However, following these guidelines can help you avoid potential water-waste fines:

- Turn off power to the pool's filtration system and the automatic water fill valve.
- Find the sewer clean-out port near your home (usually in the ground near a water spigot).
- Connect a hose from the clean-out port to a submersible pump. Lower the pump into the pool's deep end, and monitor flow in the clean out-port, watching for water backup in sinks and showers. If backup happens, stop and call a plumber.
- Refill the pool promptly to prevent potential sunlight damage to the plaster.
- Delaying the switch to the summer watering schedule while refilling your pool can help you manage you water bill and avoid excessive water use.

If your pool has a dedicated sewer connection, check your owner's manual, or contact your pool contractor for specific draining instructions. Visit **snwa.com** for more information on proper pool drainage and tips on mitigating high water bills during a pool refill.

SNWA's \$5 Water Smart Landscapes Rebate Program Continues

Spring also is an ideal time to convert your thirsty grass to desert-adapted landscape through the SNWA's Water Smart Landscape Rebate program (WSL).

For a limited time, the SNWA is offering homeowners ONLY a cash incentive of \$5 per square foot of grass (up to the first 10,000 square feet) replaced by the end of 2024. Beginning in 2025, the incentive will revert to \$3 per square foot.

Since the WSL program's launch in 1999, the community has converted more than 223 million square feet of grass and has saved more than 176 billion gallons of water. In addition to the rebate, water-efficient, drip-irrigated landscaping offers numerous benefits including lower water bills, reduced maintenance, and decreased risk of water waste fees.

CODE OF CONDUCT

PURPOSE: To provide for the safety, convenience and enjoyment of the homeowners or tenants and their guests in Los Prados, the Board of Directors has established the following rules pertaining to the conduct of the homeowners, tenants and their guests while using the Common Areas or participating in Association sponsored events, or participating in a round of golf, or while in the restaurant. A homeowner and/or tenant shall be personally and financially responsible for the failure of any individual who is a guest of the homeowner or tenants to comply with these rules.

- A. Individuals shall conduct themselves so as not to jeopardize or interfere with the right and privileges of others and shall not compromise the safety of others by their actions.
- **B.** Individuals shall obey all safety rules, including but not limited to, traffic safety signs such as stop signs and speed limit signs, and shall discontinue all unsafe activity immediately upon direction from management or security staff.
- C. Individuals shall refrain from loud, profane, indecent or abusive language or acts when addressing other persons, including but not limited to, homeowners, tenants, management, staff, Association contactors and/or guests.
- D. Individuals shall not physically abuse, harass, accost, reprimand, threaten, harass or otherwise in engage in a course of conduct against any other person, including but not limited to, any resident, guest, staff member, director or contractor. The prohibited acts stated herein are subject to NRS 116, which addresses that such action(s) causing harm or serious emotional distress, or the reasonable apprehension thereof to the person or creates a hostile environment for that person, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

COMPLIANCE MONTHLY REMINDER

ACC GUIDELINES V. K. LAMPPOSTS: "Lampposts in front of residences will be black in color and maintained as required. The light must be white and, as a minimum, be equivalent to 60 watts. Replacement lampposts must be a minimum of 6 feet above the surrounding surface grade. Solar powered lampposts require ACC Approval."

Please refrain from using colored, flashing, decorative (flames) etc. lights in lampposts. All lights must be white.

A WORD FROM THE PRO SHOP....

Golf Cart Parking:

We ask that all Homeowners who have their own private golf cart to please refrain from parking their golf carts in the cart barn. Personal carts interfere with operations and can become a safety issue. Everyone's cooperation would be greatly appreciated.

Member Tee Times:

We ask that all the members who tend to have the same tee time to please check with the Starter or the Pro Shop two weeks prior to the time of your round and confirm the number of players that will be present. We have had many groups who under book their tee times. It would be very helpful to know the exact number of players that are playing with each group so we can best accommodate everyone. We ask that you also please let us know if your tee time needs to be cancelled for any reason so we may release that time.

Driving/Walking on Course:

We ask all homeowners and guests to help us by not using the golf course cart paths as your road home or a walking path. It is a safety issue as well as a courtesy to the golfers playing the course. This includes after hours as well as in the evening. If you see someone on the course that is not playing, please call the golf shop at 702-645-5696 or the security rover at 702-524-2986.

The Dress Code for Los Prados applies any time you are utilizing the golf amenities. Please adhere to this policy even when just coming out to practice. Denim is allowed but must be in good repair. 



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
