Summer watering restrictions now in effect through August

As summer approaches, the Southern Nevada Water Authority (SNWA) is reminding residents and businesses to continue their support in conserving our region's precious water resources by following the community's mandatory summer watering restrictions, in effect **May 1 through August 31**.

- The summer restrictions **prohibit** spray irrigation between **11 a.m. and 7 p.m.**, when water can be lost to intense heat and high winds.
- Watering in the early morning or evening reduces the amount of water lost to evaporation.
- Watering during prohibited hours or allowing water to spray or flow off your property is considered water waste and may result in a costly **fine**.
- Irrigate grass with pop-up sprinklers for a maximum of **12 minutes per watering day**, set in three four-minute cycles, spaced one hour apart. That's all your grass needs.
- And remember, **Sunday watering is prohibited year-round!**

Over-watering plants and trees with drip irrigation can do more harm than good, as most plants and trees can thrive when watered less often, such as on a two or three-day per week summer schedule. These water-efficient plants have distinct needs compared to grass and can thrive on less water even in hotter conditions. Drip systems typically run for 30 to 90 minutes, depending on the flow rate of the emitters.

By following seasonal watering restrictions year-round, you can save up to \$300 annually on your water bills.

CODE OF CONDUCT

PURPOSE: To provide for the safety, convenience and enjoyment of the homeowners or tenants and their guests in Los Prados, the Board of Directors has established the following rules pertaining to the conduct of the homeowners, tenants and their guests while using the Common Areas or participating in Association sponsored events, or participating in a round of golf, or while in the restaurant. A homeowner and/or tenant shall be personally and financially responsible for the failure of any individual who is a guest of the homeowner or tenants to comply with these rules.

- A. Individuals shall conduct themselves so as not to jeopardize or interfere with the right and privileges of others and shall not compromise the safety of others by their actions.**
- B. Individuals shall obey all safety rules, including but not limited to, traffic safety signs such as stop signs and speed limit signs, and shall discontinue all unsafe activity immediately upon direction from management or security staff.**
- C. Individuals shall refrain from loud, profane, indecent or abusive language or acts when addressing other persons, including but not limited to, homeowners, tenants, management, staff, Association contactors and/or guests.**
- D. Individuals shall not physically abuse, harass, accost, reprimand, threaten, harass or otherwise in engage in a course of conduct against any other person, including but not limited to, any resident, guest, staff member, director or contractor. The prohibited acts stated herein are subject to NRS 116, which addresses that such action(s) causing harm or serious emotional distress, or the reasonable apprehension thereof to the person or creates a hostile environment for that person , shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.**

WEEDS & LANDSCAPING

- Weed season has arrived! Please ensure all landscaping is cleaned up and maintained.
 - CC&R's Article XII, Section 23; Each Lot, unit or Parcel acquired from the Declarant on which there is a completed dwelling shall be maintained in a neat condition by the owner thereof. In this context, the words "Lot, "Unit" or "Parcel" shall include that portion of property from the boundary of the Lot, Unit or Parcel to the adjacent paved road surface. "Neat" shall require, at a minimum, that the lawn be regularly cut and fertilized and that the mulched areas be regularly re-mulched and kept weeded so that its appearance is in harmony with the neighborhood.

Resident Compliance Complaints – We request that all compliance complaints be communicated in writing by submitting an email at compliance@lospradosgolf.com or by filling out the Compliance Form. The form can be filled out anonymously and can be picked up at the front desk.

A WORD FROM THE PRO SHOP....

Golf Cart Parking:

We ask that all Homeowners who have their own private golf cart to please refrain from parking their golf carts in the cart barn. Personal carts interfere with operations and can become a safety issue. Everyone's cooperation would be greatly appreciated.

Member Tee Times:

We ask that all the members who tend to have the same tee time to please check with the Starter or the Pro Shop two weeks prior to the time of your round and confirm the number of players that will be present. We have had many groups who under book their tee times. It would be very helpful to know the exact number of players that are playing with each group so we can best accommodate everyone. We ask that you also please let us know if your tee time needs to be cancelled for any reason so we may release that time.

Driving/Walking on Course:

We ask all homeowners and guests to help us by not using the golf course cart paths as your road home or a walking path. It is a safety issue as well as a courtesy to the golfers playing the course. This includes after hours as well as in the evening. If you see someone on the course that is not playing, please call the golf shop at 702-645-5696 or the security rover at 702-524-2986.

Dress Code:

The Dress Code for Los Prados applies any time you are utilizing the golf amenities. Please adhere to this policy even when just coming out to practice. Denim is allowed but must be in good repair. Collared shirts are required and mock neck golf shirts are also acceptable, however T-shirts are not allowed. Thank you!

Reminder:

With the warm weather approaching fast, make sure that you check your golf cart batteries at least once a month to ensure they have adequate water. Also, try to avoid dehydration by drinking lots of water and electrolytes!

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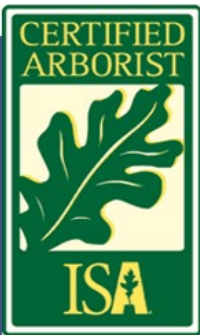


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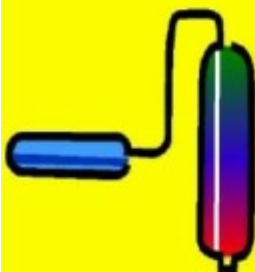
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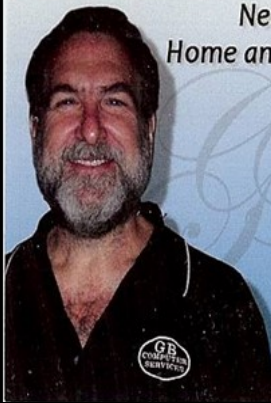
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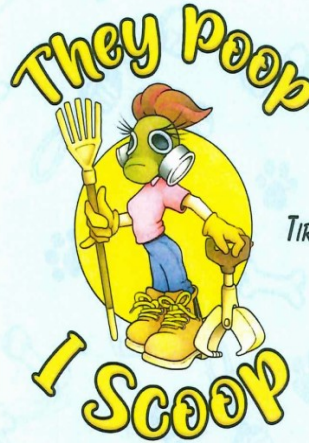
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Try this refreshing recipe for your Memorial Day Celebration!

## No-Bake Greek Yogurt Tart

### Ingredients:

- 15 pitted dates, soaked in warm water for 10 minutes
- 3/4 cup unsalted cashews
- 3/4 cup unsalted almonds
- 1 cup Greek yogurt (*plain or any flavor*)
- assorted sliced fresh fruit
- optional for topping: 2 Tablespoons apricot preserves mixed with 1 Tablespoon water



### Instructions:

Spray the bottom of a 9-inch pan with nonstick spray. Line with parchment paper. The parchment prevents the crust from sticking to the pan, and the nonstick spray helps keep the parchment in place as you press in the crust.

1. Soak the dates in warm water for 10 minutes. Drain them, and then cut in half before using.
2. In a food processor or blender, pulse the dates, cashews, and almonds together until a thick “dough” is formed and the nuts are all broken up. The dough will be sticky. Press evenly into prepared tart pan and partly up the sides.

Spread the yogurt on top of the crust. Decorate with fresh fruit. Mix together the optional preserves and water topping, and brush the fruit for a glossy finish.

3. Slice and serve immediately or cover and refrigerate for up to 1 day before serving. Cover and store leftover tart in the refrigerator for up to 3 days.
